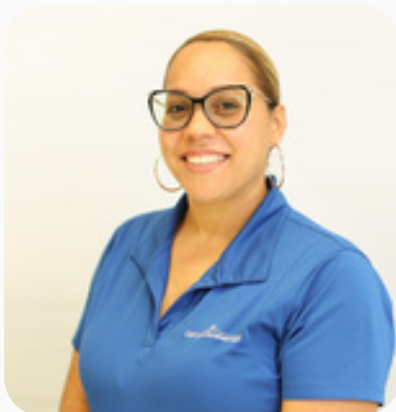


## **Liddy Romero**

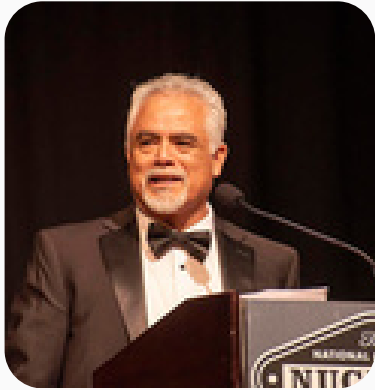
